I struggle to imagine what it would be like to rely on growing food to feed your family. Florence and her son Moses are doing just that and are enjoying eating what they grow!

Meet Florence



"Learning new farming technologies has helped us greatly increase yields from our farm. Thanks to Send a Cow Kenya," Florence.

Florence started to work with Send a Cow last year and has already noticed a transformation in her family's lives. Previously, Florence and her family often skipped meals as there was no money for food and they were not able to grow enough vegetables on their land. They would often experience six long months of hunger.

Within a period of eight months, Florence has noticed a great change in her family. She has reported an improvement in nutrition; they often eat eight different kinds of food a day and they no longer skip meals. Instead of having to buy vegetables, they now save the money. The family's income has increased and Florence is

able to buy other food that they do not produce at home to ensure a balanced diet.

Moses, Florence's son, has chosen to stay at home and support his mother farming the land. It's unusual to find a young man taking up this role as so many head to the cities to find employment. But Moses is enjoying this work and has ambitions for the future. He wants to breed both chickens and dairy cows.
